

TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR LENDING WHEELCHAIRS

at the State Museum at Majdanek

1. Whenever these Terms and Conditions refer to:

1) Museum – it refers to the State Museum at Majdanek, ulica Droga Męczenników Majdanka 67, Lublin;

2) wheelchair – it refers to a wheelchair owned by the Museum, marked with an individual identification number;

3) COZ – it refers to Visitor Service Center located on the premises of the Museum;

2. In order to visit the Museum, the Museum may provide visitors with a wheelchair (free of charge).

3. A wheelchair can be provided to an adult who presents a valid identity card with a photo. 4. The number of wheelchairs is limited. Lending a wheelchair may take place under the condition that it is available.

5. Lending of wheelchairs may take place during the working hours of COZ indicated on the Museum's website.

6. The return of the wheelchairs to COZ must take place on the day of lending, during the working hours of COZ.

7. The Museum does not bear any responsibility for accidents and damages, both to the borrower and third parties, resulting from the use of the equipment by the borrower. The borrower waives any claims against the Museum due to accidents, damages or injuries caused while using the wheelchair, except when the damage is due to the improper technical condition of the wheelchair.

8. When handing over a wheelchair, the person who lends the wheelchair is obliged to check its condition.

9. A person who lends a wheelchair is obliged to use the wheelchair on the premises of the Museum along the designated routes, as intended, and to ensure proper supervision over it.

10. In case of damage or theft of the wheelchair, the person using the wheelchair should immediately inform COZ.

11. The person who borrowed the wheelchair is responsible for the wheelchair until it is returned.
12. In case of damage of the wheelchair by the fault of the person who borrowed the wheelchair, he/she is obliged to cover the costs of its repair.
13. In case of circumstances referred to in paragraph (12), a protocol will be prepared containing all the arrangements.
14. The wheelchair should be returned in a non-deteriorated condition resulting from the normal, proper and intended use of the wheelchair.
15. A person borrowing a wheelchair may not lend the wheelchair to third parties.
16. A person who has borrowed a wheelchair may not make any repairs of the wheelchair or make any permanent changes to it.
17. In case of any defects being found, the person who borrowed the wheelchair is obliged to notify the COZ employee.
18. If the wheelchair is not returned, the person who borrowed the wheelchair is obliged to return its equivalent.
19. Lending a wheelchair requires the prior signing of a declaration with the content specified in Appendix No. 1 to these Terms and Conditions.
